INVITATION TO ENTER

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to all artists 18 years and older working in any 2-D or 3-D media except photography or digital media. Artists may submit to three works for consideration.

LIMITATIONS

Artwork that will not be accepted includes: artwork completed more than three years ago; artwork completed from how-to videos or premade kits; artwork that is a reproduction of another artist's work; artwork previously entered into a GAA Juried Show or Gadsden Museum of Art show; artwork created for a college course or any other third-party institution; artwork that is not ready to hang upon arrival.

SIZE

Due to space constrictions, two-dimensional works exceeding 5 feet, and sculptures and other three-dimensional works exceeding a 4ft x 4ft cube will not be considered. The artist must contact rwetzel@cityofgadsden.com for any accepted work requiring special installation or instruction, or any work exceeding 150 lbs.

COST

The cost of entry is \$40 for up to three submissions. Payments may be made in cash, check, or money order payable to the Gadsden Art Association. This fee is non-refundable. All money collected will be used as prize money and show expenses. Checks and entry form must be mailed to GAA, P.O. Box 973, Gadsden, AL 35902.

JURYING

The jury consists of an art professional and two Art Association members. Jurying will be based on digital images. Email all digital images to: elainecampbell425@gmail.com. Please make sure your images are high quality. Send one image per two-dimensional work and two images per three-dimensional work.

When naming the digital files, use first three letters of last name in all uppercase followed by first five letters of work title in lowercase. For example, John Smith's work titled Landscape would be saved as SMllands.jpg. Please no works "untitled" — untitled works make it difficult at notification and labeling stages. Artist will be notified by email if work is accepted.

Accepted artwork must arrive at the Gadsden Museum of Art (515 Broad Street, Gadsden, AL 35901) by Friday, July 17.

JUDGING

The judge will be a qualified working artist with an exhibition record and credentials for assessing artwork. Judging will be done in person at the Gadsden Museum of Art after accepted work has

arrived and is hanging. Judging will be take place in six categories: oil, acrylic, watercolor, dry media, mixed media, and three-dimensional work. Awards will be given at the judge's discretion.

DELIVERY

Artist is responsible for shipping and dropping off work to the Gadsden Museum of Art. Neither the Gadsden Art Association nor the Gadsden Museum of Art will be responsible for any damage incurred during transit. Any art work damaged while on display will be covered at cost of materials and not the artist asking price. For works dropped off, any packing or wrapping materials with artworks must be labeled to insure the same packing is returned to artist at the exhibit's end. All work must be picked up no later than 1 week after the exhibit's end. Art unclaimed one month after the show closes becomes the property of the Gadsden Museum of Art. Shipped work without pre-paid documents for return will be considered unclaimed and become the property of the Gadsden Museum of Art. Artists retain all copyrights to their work but agree that the artwork may be reproduced in print and digital form for promoting the show without compensation but with attribution by artist and title.

SALES

If artwork sells during exhibition, the artist will receive 70% of asking price. The Gadsden Museum of Art will receive 30% of asking price. The artist must submit a W9 tax form after a sale to be paid for the sale.

ENTRY FORM

Artwork will not be considered until all four parts of the entry are received: digital images, entry form, jury fee, and submissions form. Please complete this form and mail to the Gadsden Art Association (P.O. Box 973, Gadsden, AL 35902) with your entry fee. Payments may be cash, check, or money order.
